- Review of the Minutes of the last Meeting. The President said that the minutes of the last meeting has been circulated and asked if there were any comments regarding the minutes. As there were no comments, the same was approved.
- Annual Jassi Memorial Mayo Golf Tournament and Mayo Annual Dinner. Following key points have been discussed:
 - Mr. Jagbir Sidhu proposed a targeted approach, suggesting reaching out to 10-12 sponsors for amounts ranging from 2 to 3 lakhs, estimating a total collection of 20 to 25 lakhs.
 - Mr. Sameer Mutreja recommended creating a comprehensive event package for sponsors but acknowledged time constraints. This approach, however, not feasible presently, is considered a favorable pitching strategy.
 - The decision was taken to reach out to the following Mayoites for sponsorship:

 - Mr. Sameer Mutreja proposed approaching DLF for sponsorship of Mayo Golf at their course.
 - The decision was taken to increase the participation charges for the Annual Jassi Memorial Mayo Golf Tournament. Increase charges are as follows:
 - · Rs 10,000/- for Life Members
 - · Rs 11,000/- for Non Members & Golfers pay at the course
 - Rs 9,000/- for Students, Out Station and Lady Golfers
 - The members expressed a preference for an afternoon tee-off instead of a morning.
 - The President requested Mr Rudra Shriram to communicate with Mr Vikramaditya Jaitly and discuss the possibility of approaching batch coordinators for sponsorship contribution.

To make an appeal to all golfers in the whatsapp group for support.

Mr Alok Shriram agreed to reaching out to Audi and Radico with regards to the

possibility of securing them as potential lead sponsors.

The President emphasized to circulate a flyer with a message for registration in the Annual Jassi Memorial Mayo Golf Tournament. Further, the members suggested a theme for the Annual Mayo Dinner – House colour, Hat & Scarf, Smart Causals etc.

Annual Mayo Dinner

- The EC members decided the contribution charges for participants attending the Annual Mayo Dinner as follows:
 - Rs 3.000/- for Life Members
 - Rs 3,500/- for Non Members & Golfers pay at the course
 - Rs 2,500/- for Students
- Mr Rudra Shriram has agreed to conduct research on securing a band/live music for dinner, considering Qutab Golf Club regulations, and provide information accordingly.
- 3. MAAD website and App. Mr. Dipin Kapur shared progress updates on the MAAD App, confirming the successful integration of all recommended features. The ongoing work includes the creation of a page for other chapters. However, a significant concern lies in reaching out to these chapters to encourage their contribution to the App. The suggestion was made that formal communication on this matter should be initiated by the MOBS President. It was agreed that further discussions on charging other chapters and incorporating their activities would be discussed in the next EC meeting.
- Mayo Annual Lecture. Since Mr Kirit Javali was not attended, it was decided to discuss in the next meeting.
- Annual Mayo Summit. Since Mr Kirit Javali was not attended, it was decided to discuss in the next meeting.
- Inter School Basketball Tournament. Ms. Divija updated the members about the
 formation of a basketball team by MCGS Alumni. The President assured that he would
 communicate this information to Mr. Pradyut Voilet, from the 2008 batch, who is managing
 the Inter-School Basketball Tournament.
