

1. **Review of the Minutes of the last Meeting.** The President said that the minutes of the last meeting had been circulated and asked if there were any comments regarding the minutes. As there were no comments, the same was approved.
2. **ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING.** The President informed the Committee that AGM is scheduled to be held at Senate Hall, Claridges Hotel on 16<sup>th</sup> September. Also, a Book launch by Mr Jagdeep Singh (Jags, 1971 batch), Jaipur is to be held in the same venue followed by AGM and the Mayo Alumni Monthly Meet at Viceroy Hall. Further, he informed the Committee that the Association has 2 positions in the Committee has become vacant. Mr Vir Vikram Yadav and Mr Sandeep Suri have resigned from the post of Secretary and Member, respectively. Further, he requested the Secretary to check with Mr Sameer Mutreja and Mr Vilas Pawar in case they wish to step down from the member's post because they were not attending the EC meeting regularly. He also, requested the Secretary to circulate the AGM Notice with the vacancies in the MAAD Committee. It was also, decided that the amendment in the AOA will be done in the next year AGM.
3. **MCGS Alumni Society.** The President informed the members that Ms Divija Singh, 2004 batch and Ms Jasleen Kochhar, 2000 batch (She is the chapter head for MCGS Alumni Society, NCR) have been formally nominated to represent MCGS Alumni Society on the MAAD Committee. The President also requested them to check with MCGS, if they want to be a part of only some of the MAAD activities or need to fully collaborate with MAAD in all its activities under one alumni umbrella in the NCR. Also, to clarify if they wanted Mayo Alumni Boys participating in the MCGS Alumni societies activities in the NCR as there has been some communication gap till now. They both confirmed that they had an initial discussion in the Delhi chapter and the President of MCGS and they were keen collaborate. The President requested them for a formal letter/communication for endorsing this collaboration.

  - The Secretary agreed to draft a contract and circulate the MAAD EC WhatsApp group and it can be signed on 16<sup>th</sup> Sept 2022.
  - Sub Committee group - Mr Dipin Kapur, Mr Pankaj Rakesh, Mr Peeyush Sharma. Confirmation from MCGS Alumni Society for their involvement - Ms Divija Singh will check and revert, and the President agrees to speak to the President-MOBS.
  - The President requested Mr Dipin Kapur for activating the attendance section on the MAAD APP for the MAAD events.
6. **Annual Jassi Memorial Mayo Golf Tournament & Annual Mayo Dinner.** The President informed the members that he is waiting for the final quote from ITC Classic for the Golf event. Quotation from Jaypee Greens have already been received. Final venue for the event and relevant details will be informed in the Committee group in a weeks' time. Approved venue for the Annual Mayo Dinner is The Claridges. He further informed that the proposed dates for the Golf event are 15<sup>th</sup> Oct at Jaypee Greens / 26<sup>th</sup> Nov at ITC.
